







Presentation of Audited Financials




• Income \$3,99m (down from \$4.08m in 2022)

Xero - Revenue by Port Size







Billing and Payments


- We keep hitting weird loopholes with Xero that don't seem important for them to fix (some have been on Xero Central for ~10 years)
