Applications are now open for the IAASysters Program promoting gender diversity in the Internet industry

The Internet Association of Australia Ltd (IAA) has today announced that applications are open for its 2024 IAASysters program. The annual event aims to encourage and support the inclusion of women in the Internet industry.

In 2024, the program will offer 10 sponsored attendees – Systers – the opportunity to take part in the one-day IAASysters Workshop, which provides expert career advice and builds soft career-advancement skills. This is followed by their attendance at the two-day AusNOG Conference – a technical event focusing on the operation of Internet networks and associated infrastructure.

IAASysters' participation at both the workshop and the conference ensures they receive relevant technical training and networking opportunities.

IAA CEO Narelle Clark said the program was launched in 2021 after identifying consistently low participation rates of certain sectors in the industry.

"We wanted to do something about it, so we did," she said.

The 2024 IAASysters program will be held from Wednesday, 4 September in Sydney. Systers will receive economy return airfares from their city of residence, accommodation, entry to the IAASysters Workshop and the AusNOG Conference, and a one-year complimentary IAA Professional Membership (subject to IAA Board approval).

To be eligible for the program, applicants must be either employed, studying or working towards a career in the Internet industry, including roles from network operations, engineering, IT, marketing,

regulation and customer support. Those demonstrating the most potential for personal growth and passion for the Internet and Internet industry are rated highest.

Applications close Friday, 26 April 2024 at 5.00pm AEST.
