

- Remove all legacy devices (in progress, ETA Aug/25)
- Migrate exchanges to EVPN VXLAN (under review; pending legacy removals)
- Compute Node refresh, significant performance issues on current 4x proxmox cluster,
   ~11yr old CPU, ceph + kube + c-states = ugly (in progress)
- DNS Re-architecture (done)
- AS10084 Content Network hardware refresh (in progress)
- **Bird BGP upgrades** Faster RPKI changes, RFC 9234 and arouteserver deployment changes (under review)
- **Looking Glass Improvements –** essentially copying <a href="https://lg.de-cix.net/">https://lg.de-cix.net/</a> :D (in progress)
- New Employee Trainee Peering Engineer (in progress)
- New Website internet.asn.au (done)
- Metrics system revamp metrics.internet.asn.au (done)



# IX Upgrades, Updates and Upheavals



### NSW-IX (done/in progress/under review)

- Consolidated 3x 32x100G switches for re-use in other exchanges (done)
- VDC-SYD01 (syd5) DC Shutdown EoL 31 May 2025 (in progress)
- Replace 3x Switches in Global Switch with single 400G box (Under Review)
- PoP NextDC S2?! (Under Review)

### VIC-IX (done/in progress/under review)

- 400G hardware on the way! Expecting delivery ~July (in progress)
- 1x new 100G device at Equinix ME1 for 10G access ports (in progress)
- PoP NextDC M2?! (Under Review)



# IX Upgrades, Updates and Upheavals



### **QLD-IX** (done/in progress/under review)

- Upgraded Steam Caches (NVME!!), old caches moved to Adelaide, pushing disks too hard for the 2x100G uplinks, woohoo! (**done**)
- NextDC B1; Mass migration of peers via old low-density SC panels, involves decommissioning of legacy switch (in progress)
- Host Networks (bne5) end of life 21st August, negative long-term growth (in progress)
- 400G Hardware upgrades, hoping before EOFY FY26 (under review)



- 100G Upgrades on the way ETA completed by 21st May (in progress)
- 3x New ZPE nodegrid (OOB) devices to support 10G minimum speed for inband path (done)
- MORE content at NextDC A1 via AS10084 to come, secret for now, currently have: Netflix, Steam, Google (in progress)
- Ring upgrade on the way, 400G into each site, ETA completed by 22nd May (in progress)



# IX Upgrades, Updates and Upheavals



### WA-IX (done/in progress/under review)

- QV1 Site Shutdown 30yr old 'bunker' data centre is a 'fun' clean up!! (in progress)
- Ring upgrade to 400G into each site + New 100G box at NextDC P1 (done)
- 100G Port availability now at VDC-PER01 Cloudflare 2x100G on the way (**done**)
- Mass migration of peers off old SC panels (same as QLD), involves legacy device decommission (under review)

### ACT-IX (done/in progress/under review)

- Core Link upgrades (under review)
- Low growth, Re-assessing ACT-IX's purpose, collapse into NSW-IX? (under review)
  - Not enough networks in ACT :-(

### TAS-IX (done/in progress/under review)

- Continued growth phase, currently still FREE
- Re-use old cache nodes for content, backhaul is expensive++, likely not for a while (under review)



### Portal!




- Optic selection is now available on order
  - Members can select from LR4 or LR1 optics for 100G ports, this information is available on LOA PDFs as well.
- MA/MSA/Other account documents now built-in. (Part of the new MSA rollout)
- Portal Billing Automation, MANY features including:
  - New Ordering page and workflows for each product type.
  - **New Cart system** that allows members to order multiple services at once, including services that are dependent on other cart items.
  - o Improved back-end actions to handle orders with multiple items.
  - o **Invoices and Account Summaries are now generated and sent out by the portal**. All payments are also via the portal or by manual bank transfer now.
  - Better pricing displays, especially where discounts were applied to services. Any
    discounted services now display their normal and discounted prices including when the
    discount expires if applicable.
  - Users can now opt-in/opt-out of a range of notification types (sorry anyone bombarded by invoice emails – fixes are on the way before next months notifications!)



### Portal Future!





- Billing Automation verification phase
  - o Currently heavily monitoring and resolving any bugs as it's such a critical feature
- IAA will then **deploy Billing Automation to NZIX**'s portal we manage
- Service Automation
  - Billing Automation took longer than expected :(
  - o Full Network Automation was intended before Billing Automation, issues came up
    - Currently ~80% complete, config is generated automatically, but manually committed to devices
  - As Billing Automation was deep in development, prioritized shipping that before focusing back on Service Automation
  - **TLDR**: Automatic service changes e.g. MAC address updates, ETA ~3 months (last member forum we stated Q2 2025, a little behind)
- Cloud Connect product revamp use APIs to auto-provision cloud connectivity (under review)


